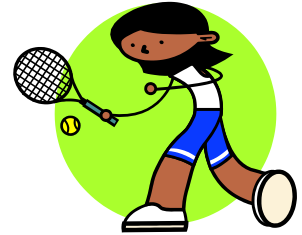

- Discuss pupils' academic and behavioral attitudes and achievements with parents.
- Keep attendance and grades as required by camp
- Assume responsibility for the care of materials, equipment, and facilities
- Assume responsibility for a neat, safe environment for students committed to their care
- Practice and promote positive interaction with and among students
- Encourage self-direction and self-motivation in students
- Utilize a variety of appropriate materials and hands-on resources
- Willingness to comply with suspected child abuse reporting (subsection (a)(7) of Section 26-1 of the state of Illinois Criminal Code)

Work Environment

Education sessions will be conducted in typical indoor classroom environments at the various campus locations.

Hours

The daily education sessions per camp site will range from 2-4 hours, depending on enrollment. Students are expected to participate in 2 hours of academic training each day (1-hour each of math and reading). Camp hours are from 8:00am to 5:00pm. Education sessions will be conducted consecutively at set times each day (ex. 9:00 am to 1:00 pm).
